



**Cape Verde : Training on “Producing Food Security Information Products that Result in Action”
23 – 27 April 2007, Tarrafal, Cape Verde.**

Twenty-two professionals from the main institutions concerned with food security in the country, working at central and decentralized levels, successfully completed this 5-day training course. Key information users were invited to present their information needs to participants and provide them with recommendations for improving their products. The course ended with the presentation of a Plan of Action for improving and creating food security information products (FSIPs) for action to the Ministry of Agriculture.

The course was jointly organized by the Direction des Services de Sécurité Alimentaire (DSSA - Ministry of Environment and Agriculture), and the EC-FAO Information for Action Programme. The training provided information producers with the necessary knowledge and skills to produce effective FSIPs for the formulation, programming and targeting of food security policies and interventions. The training course has previously been delivered in Cambodia (9-12 October 2006) and Mozambique (27 November – 1 December) and will be delivered in Burkina Faso (June 2007) and Haiti.
